



DESCRIPTION OF WORK- Primary Care Physician

Seeking the services of one (1) Full time Equivalent (FTE) Primary Care Manager Physician for Bayne Jones Army Community Hospital (BJACH), Fort Polk, LA.

Service provider shall work as part of a comprehensive healthcare team to evaluate and treat patients with Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). The contract service provider must possess sound clinical reasoning and be able to synthesize complex evaluation and diagnosis data to develop individualized comprehensive plans of care. Service may also be required in the Primary/Family Care Clinic, Urgent Care Clinic, or Soldier Readiness Processing site.

QUALIFICATIONS.

The Physician **must** meet the following minimum qualifications:

- License/registration. Personal services contractors must have and maintain a current, active, valid, unrestricted state license to practice medicine in one of the 50 states in the United States, or the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam or the US Virgin Islands as required to obtain or renew a DEA registration number under the then effective DEA rules. License must correspond to DEA registration number.
- Medical Education and Hospitals of the AMA or Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.) degree from a college or university accredited by the American Osteopathic Association.
- Must be board eligible or board certified in family practice or primary care by the American Board of Medical Specialties.
- A minimum of two years within the past four years in an appropriate area of Primary Care. Related experience will not be accepted in lieu of degree or license requirements.
- Have and maintain current Basic Cardiac Life Support (BLS), Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS),
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), and Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) certification by way of an American Heart Association approved training program. Should the provider require recertification the costs for the recertification shall be borne by the contractor.
- Graduates of foreign medical schools are required to possess both a medical license and other certification by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) or 4th Pathway.
- Must be able to read, write, and speak English fluently to be able to communicate effectively with patients and other healthcare providers.
- Must be required to meet Continuing Medical Education (CME) requirements. The government will not reimburse for these costs.

HOURS OF PERFORMANCE.

Normal duty hours are 0800-1630 Monday through Friday excluding Federal holidays and an occasional training holiday. A 30-minute un-paid break will be given during the shift as determined by the clinic. Overtime is not authorized.
